Re: Weekly Status for 29 OCT – 2 NOV 2007

- **Update on Middle Island Sewer Project** – The crew was back to work after Wednesday installing concrete vaults and air release valves along Cape Creek Road. Currently near Lot #1074...
- **State Regional Meeting to Discuss Drought** – Calvin attended the meeting on Tuesday with other local government officials throughout the state. Updates from state and federal experts on the status of the drought, information on how to identify supplemental water sources, how to implement water conservation efforts and impacts of water rate structures were discussed. Overall BHI is on track with its water shortage response plan.
- **Utilities Personnel Attended County Meeting** – David Suther attended the Brunswick County meeting regarding water conservation on Tuesday.
- **2007 Property Tax Bills** – Tax bills were put in the mail on Friday afternoon. All property owners should be receiving their respective bills soon.
- **Hurricane Floodwater Management Plan** – As part of on-going efforts of the Village to mitigate stormwater from major tropical storms & hurricanes (Hurricane Floodwater Management Plan – HFMP), stormwater infrastructure is being replaced in the by-pass lagoon adjacent to hole #6. Replacement of the deteriorated outlet structure with a new weir gate will continue to provide the Village with a means to release excess stormwater off the island.
