Re: Weekly Status for 3 – 7 SEP 2007

- **Westervelt Deer Census Study** – Cameras have been set up for the census and sites are baited...
- **Potential Storm Activity Update** – B.C. EMS had a 1400 conference call and weather center county municipalities. At this point the storm is located approximately 500 to 600 miles off the coast southeast of BHI. The Hurricane Hunter is being sent out to collect more data that will determine if the storm will be named officially. Should the storm be named B.C. EOC will activate the web EOC.

The system needs moisture and the weather center has indicated that the moisture is out there and would be enough to feed the system possibly creating a “moderate” tropical system. We may see impacts in the form of rain, wind, and some erosion possibly starting Sunday a.m.
