- **Erosion on East Beach** – Staff has been working quickly to acquire all adjacent property owner notifications for a potential sand push along east beach properties, specifically from 1 to 31 East Beach Drive and 234 Station House Way to reconstruct the frontal dune where erosion has completely wiped out the dune. DENR included in the Emergency General Permit conditions the ability to push from normal low tide to the escarpment under the permit conditions which will not require a Major Permit. Staff has also talked with the Corps regarding endangered species and Suzanne w/ the Conservancy has called them to notify that there are no turtle eggs or other endangered species in the general vicinity.
- **Deer Census** – Westervelt has completed the field work for study. All cameras have been removed and film for processing.
- **Water & Sewer Availability Fees** – All letters have been mailed out to property owners of unimproved lots that were being charged an availability fee letting them know of the termination of collection and subsequent refund.
