2007 Wastewater Report

House Bill 1160, the Clean Water Act of 1999, was ratified by the North Carolina General Assembly on July 20 and signed into law by the Governor on July 21, 1999. This legislation placed significant reporting requirements on those entities that own or operate wastewater treatment and collection systems. In compliance with this Act, The Village of Bald Head Island, Utilities Department provides an annual report to its users and to the NC Department of Environment and Natural Resources. This report will be made available to the public each year. To reach all of our customers, we are mailing a copy of this 2007 report. This report summarizes the treatment works or collection system performance from January 1, 2007 until December 31, 2007 and states the extent to which any terms of its permit, federal laws, state laws, regulations or rules related to the protection of water quality have been violated.

The Village of Bald Head Island, Utilities Department wastewater treatment facility operates in accordance with the provisions of Article 21 of Chapter 143, General Statutes of North Carolina as amended, and other applicable Laws, Rules, and Regulations under permit number WQ0000193 and is monitored by David A. Suther, Operator in Responsible Charge. The collection system consists of 166,650 feet of sewer mains with size ranging from 2" to 10" in diameter, and 38 lift stations, which collect and convey waste to the treatment plant for processing. This collection system is monitored by Kenneth D. Bowling, Operator in Responsible Charge.

The Wastewater Treatment Facility was designed by McKim & Creed Engineers, PA and began its initial service November 1996. An expansion to the existing wastewater treatment plant was brought online in June 2003. The facility is a state of the art Aqua-Aerobic System with sequencing batch reactors and tertiary treatment. We are continually looking for new and innovative ideas to improve our system and accommodate future growth on Bald Head Island.

Below are the year 2007 average monthly test results for the four major components monitored.
